Applications for participation in the Congress and abstracts of the reports (1.5 - 2 thousand characters) will be accepted from **January 15 to August 15, 2025**.

An electronic Collection of Materials of the Congress will be published with the full text of scientific articles. The collection will be posted in the RSCI.

Publication is free. Requirements for publication will be on the official website of the congress https://yktbc.nlrs.ru/.

Submissions for publication will be accepted until November 15, 2025.

There is no participation fee for the Congress.
